"In Malaysia it was decided that the best opportunity for me would be to find my own way through the different departments as well as to work on small projects and matters which were thought to be important and worthwhile. I ended up working closely with the project cargo department, the national seafreight manager and initiated some smaller marketing projects on my own.

Work for the national seafreight manager was usually at short notice, and included the preparation of presentations or the analysis and summary of data. In the project cargo department, work included everything from the acquisition of cargo to pricing to the supervision of loading and unloading procedures to billing. Tasks in this department took me and the rest of the team to places nobody would ever think they existed - it was highly interesting.

The last block was marketing. This included everything from building up an address/email database to designing email flyers to research on specific customers or industries.
